Desert Hills III West Communications Protocols

Approved by the Desert Hills III West Board of Directors on December 5, 2020

The purpose of these protocols is to improve and maintain efficient, accurate and timely communication between the Board of Directors (board) and the members of the association.

Primary Communications

- The primary and official method of notifications from the Board to members and residents will be via email and posting on the HOA website (<u>www.dh3west.com</u>). Therefore, each owner and renter must register on the website and provide current contact information on the member or guest profile.
- This protocol does not override any legal requirement for correspondence method required by statute or other corporate rules (bylaws, CC&Rs).
- This protocol does not prevent the use of supplemental methods to distribute information to owners and/or renters. However, email and the HOA website will provide the most current and reliable source.
- Owner members must communicate critical information to their renters.

Supplemental Communications

• Notices and other documents suitable for public viewing may be posted at select locations approved by the board and at the HOA bulletin board located on South Calle Pueblo at Camino Tolteca. Notices may also be mailed or distributed by hand if appropriate.

Communications to the Board

- Periodically, surveys and questionnaires may be circulated for electronic response.
